Tuesday, June 20, 10:30-11:30, Banana Robotics, Presented by the McLean County Extension Office.

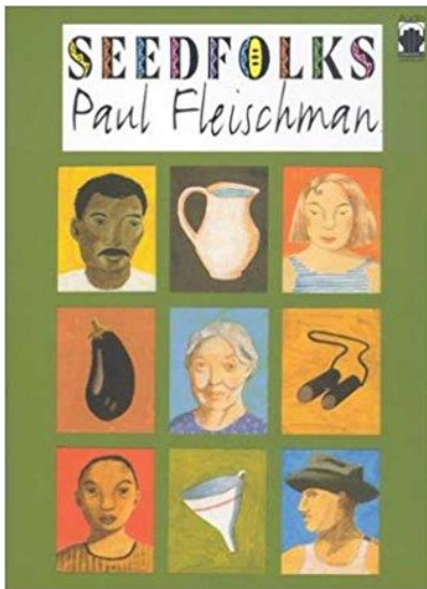
