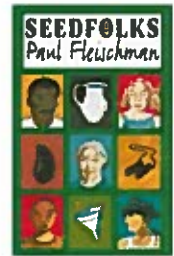


- Tuesday, May 30, 4:00** – April the Lego Lady will bring Legos and a special program for all ages
