## **Think Spring**

With spring time quickly approaching and better weather ahead I wanted to prepare for spring projects people might be planning. First, as always if you see a storm water drainage issue or potholes in the roadway please let City Hall or myself know to get on the list, but please remember that doesn't mean it will be filled the next day, we have work scheduled and will get it added / fit in when work allows.

If you have a stump in your city right of way from previous trees being removed please let City Hall or myself know, we are planning on grinding stumps sometime this spring and want to get all that we can at once.

Speaking of trees and shrubs, City Code 7-2-1 states that it shall be unlawful to plant, remove, or cut any tree or shrub in the right of way without first obtaining a permit from City Hall. This helps control good healthy living trees being removed without good cause and it helps from trees being planted over utilities that in the future the city would need to maintain thus having to remove the tree or shrub you worked so hard to grow for all those years!

Another couple of right of way issues that are overlooked and I'd like to bring attention to is when installing a new driveway or parking spot in front of your property in the city right of way, a permit needs to be applied for first. City code 7-1-10, Preservation of Green Spaces summarized states that anytime green space is being removed to be graveled or paved which permanently removes the green space, a permit needs to be filed with City Hall. If a ditch or waterway needs to be filled or altered a permit must be applied for also.


